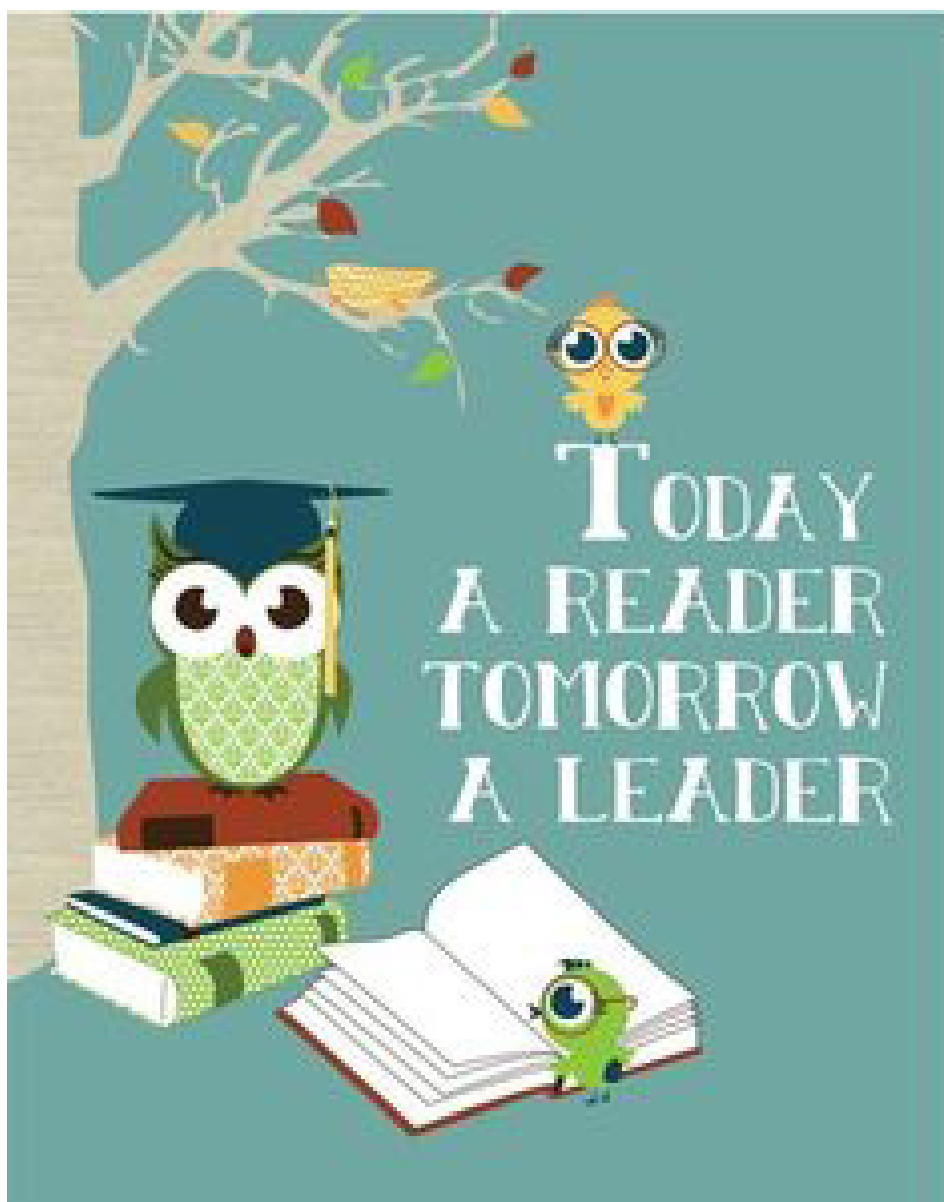

**MEAN.**

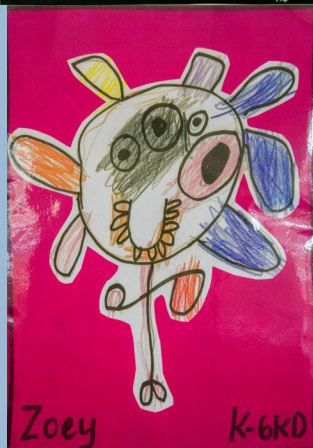
When someone says or does something
