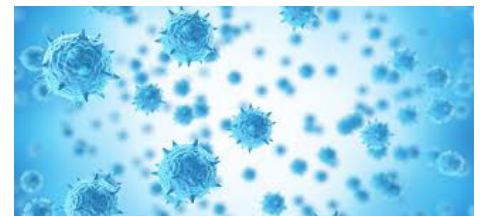
Student Mobile Phones

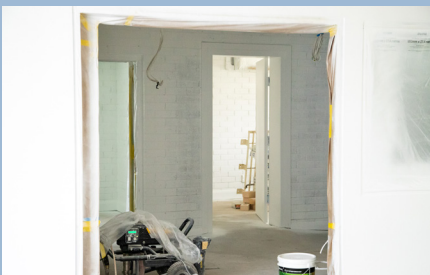
As teachers and educators, we all know that social and emotional intelligence is second to none in terms of health and happiness; as they say EQ > IQ in life!

Our Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 classes will participate in the program. Engaging with stories and the unique monsters to develop their understanding of emotions.

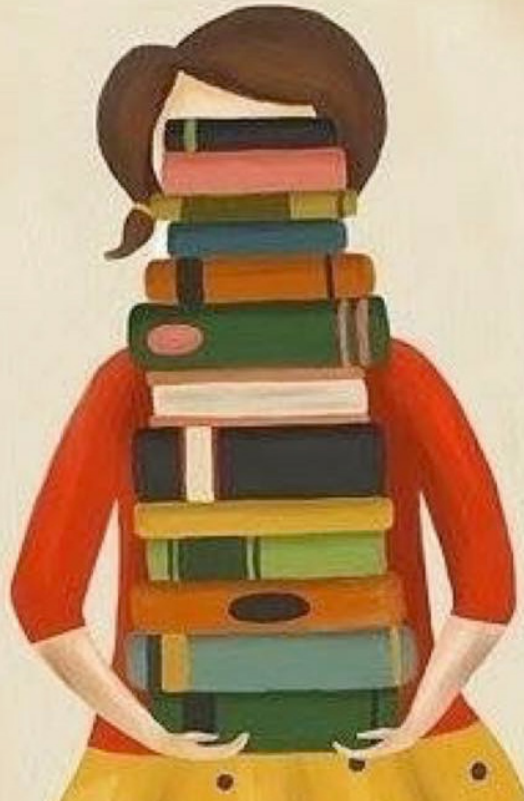
