₩ We will continue with the early departure of K-2 students and their siblings. The supported learning students will also continue with their early departure. This initiative has been an amazing success as it has ensured the only people on site are our students, staff and our after school care students. Prior to this afternoon departures have been slightly chaotic.

☼ Non-essential adults are still not permitted on school grounds or at school events – this includes parents/carers unless specifically approved by the school.

- ☼ Band lessons will resume from next Tuesday morning. Don't forget your instruments.
- ⇔ School assemblies will still be run by Zoom. No decision has been made on our Silver assembly. However, the Term 2 Assembly of Excellence has been cancelled.
- Non-contact sport has resumed. There are no interschool competitions. We want to try to hold some sort of Cross Country and Athletics carnivals in the future, possibly next term depending on restrictions.
- ☼ Scripture and Ethics Classes may resume in Term 3 depending on the availability of personnel to teach these classes.
- ☼ Choirs may recommence in Term 3.
- ☼ Parent meetings are to still be via the phone. Communication can be made by phone, email or Seesaw.
- All adults must maintain physical distance from each other (1.5m) including teachers, support staff and parents.
- ☼ Our school photos will be held in August.


