We have recently purchased additional technology equipment to ensure suitable resources are available for use at all stages of learning, from Kindergarten to Year 6.

Equipment includes:

MakeyMakeys, micro:bits, Lego WeDo2.0 kits, Lego EV3 Mindstorms kits, Edison robots, Spheros, Code-apillars, BeeBots and a Green screen. This is in addition to the iPads, laptops and computer labs that are already in use at our school on a daily basis.

STEM education provides students with opportunities to develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills, and demonstrate their knowledge in creative ways. It also equips students with the skills and capabilities needed to participate in the workforce of the future. We are looking forward to exploring our new resources.
