Below is the suggested list for school equipment and some important reminders re: uniform. These items help us to implement daily classroom activities. These items are NOT part of the WPS uniform: Leggings, bike pants, black shorts or navy shorts with large brand names. Shorts and skorts are to be of a length suitable for active kids in primary school.
