Wauchope Bonny Hills Surf Life Saving Club (WBHSLSC)

Wauchope Bonny Hills Surf Life Saving Club (WBHSLSC) has been teaching Nippers (U6's to U14's) about how to swim and survive in the ocean since 1958.

As children enter High School on the Mid North Coast (MNC), they often end up going to the beach with friends, unaccompanied by adults. The long, open beaches of the MNC can be dangerous and many people are not equipped with the knowledge and skills to get themselves out of trouble in the surf.

At Nippers, children will be taught how to detect rips, not panic in a rip, and how to swim out of a rip. They will learn how to body surf, how to dolphin dive under waves, how to swim and sight between waves, and how to use waves to get them back to shore.

There will be a meet and greet, tour the club house etc. session at the WBHSLS Club House at Bonny Hills on Friday 27 September 2024 from 4:00 to 5:00 pm.

Nippers is held on Sunday mornings at Rainbow Beach, Bonny Hills. The first Nippers morning will be held on Sunday 20 October 2024 starting at 9:00 am. Please use the QR code on the attached flyer for registering your child.




